DAY 5 - **City tour** includes the **Cathedral** and the **home of Pancho Villa**, who led the troops of the Northern Division during the Revolutionary War. Depart Chihuahua traveling through Torreon to Parras, the **Oasis of the Desert**. Enjoy dinner before nodding off to dreamland in this serene setting. **Overnight** at the **Rincon del Montero** in **Parras**. **D**

DAY 6 - **Parras** is famous for their candies - they are to die for. Also they have the oldest winery in the Americas. Then it is homeward bound through **Saltillo** where you can buy Pan de Pulque. What a trip!! **B**
