Come join in the fun as we celebrate the 40th consecutive year of the Texas Folklife Festival, the largest cultural celebration in Texas. What a wonderful experience for your children and grandchildren. Gather up your brood and let's go watch how grandma and great grandma made soap and candles and hand made quilts. Listen to music of all the different ethnic groups that settled in Texas. Sample foods from the different cultural groups. You will have a great time at the Texas Folklife Festival held on the grounds of the Institute of Texan Cultures.

DAY 1 - San Antonio - Texas #1 destination. Our Go..With Jo! professional driver will take you on our charter coach to San Antonio where you arrive around mid-day. Choose a place for lunch in the downtown area. Then take a tour through the famed Alamo. Begin with Long Barracks, then enter the Mission Church with a last stop in the gift shop where you can visually see in the diorama how the Texans were so outnumbered. Check in to our hotel for a brief rest before we venture to the "Kick Back" for hot and cold snacks at the hotel. The younger ones - and maybe not so young ones will probably find hot dogs on the buffet line. Tonights entertainment includes the Saga, a technicolor tribute to the Heroes of The Alamo, displayed on the front of the San Fernando Cathedral. **Overnight at the Drury Plaza Hotel San Antonio Riverwalk.**

DAY 2 - After your **included buffet breakfast**, we will enjoy an **included narrated boat cruise** on the **San Antonio River**. Then our charter coach carries us to the Institute of Texan Cultures where you have all day to enjoy the **Texas Folklife Festival** and the **Institute of Texan Cultures**. Be sure to wear cool clothing and comfortable shoes. At a prescheduled time, those who are in need of a little rest can hop on the coach for a ride back to the hotel. Later we will enjoy the "Kick Back" before returning to the **Festival**. If you prefer, let the guide know that you will NOT be

returning for more fun time at the **Texas Folklife Festival**. **Overnight at the Drury Plaza Hotel San Antonio Riverwalk.**
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DAY 3 - Enjoy your **included buffet breakfast**. For those history buffs you will want to visit the **San Fernando Cathedral** which is directly behind our hotel. A good time to visit would be between 7 and 8 or between 9 and 10 a.m. as there is a Mass scheduled at 6am and also at 8am. The **Mexican troops led by Santa Ana** made this church their headquarters before the **Battle of the Alamo**. A flag of "no quarter" was flown from the belfry. As the Mexican troops charged the Alamo, General Santa Ana ordered his trumpeters to play "el Deguello" indicating that the fight would be to the finish and no prisoners would be taken. Today the ashes of the **Heroes of the Alamo** are kept in a sarcophagus located in the left vestibule of the church. **Visit Market Square** and another icon of San Antonio, the **Mi Tierra Restaurant**, established in 1936 and still owned and operated by the same family. After lunch, leave for South Texas arriving back home around 8:00pm **B, L**
